Dear Parent/Guardian

I am writing to invite your child to our two day Sixth Form Induction commencing on Thursday 20 June 2019 for two days. This is a change to the proposed date of Monday 1 July 2019

As we are running a collegiate Sixth Form with one of our Trust school, Cheslyn Hay Academy, the first induction day will be at Cheslyn Hay Academy so that those students who are studying courses at Cheslyn Hay are familiar with the school, staff and facilities in preparation for September. The second day of induction will be at Great Wyrley Academy.

We are advising students who are intending to study courses at Cheslyn Hay Academy to attend both induction days. Students whose courses are all based at Great Wyrley Academy may wish to just attend Day 2 but are more than welcome to go to both days if they feel that their course choices may change.

Students will be expected to make their own way to Cheslyn Hay Academy on the Monday ready for a 9.00am start where Great Wyrley Academy staff will be there to support them through the day. Pupils are expected to wear smart business dress for this day and are advised to bring either a packed lunch or money for lunch on both days.

During the second day at Great Wyrley Academy, pupils will be made aware of what it means to be a Sixth Form student, they will receive information on lesson protocols, attendance policy, the PSHE programme, enrichment opportunities and other pieces of vital information so that they feel as prepared as possible before their possible start in September.

During this day pupils will also have an opportunity to review their subject choices and confirm their choices in readiness for GCSE results day where pupils will receive their formal invitation to join the Sixth Form if they have met the entry requirements for their chosen course.

It is important to remember that this induction is **not compulsory** but we feel that it will give pupils a good insight into the expectations for September and hopefully alleviate any concerns or worries they might have. For anyone who is unable to attend information can be sent via post or results day in August.
